Follow the onscreen prompts—you'll need the email address we have on file for you, your school ID number, or your 7-digit SR ID, located on your medical insurance ID card.

Select a user name and password. Your user name must contain 6–30 alphanumeric characters. Your password must have 8–12 characters and include at least three of the following: an uppercase character, a lowercase character, a numeric character (0–9), and a special character (e.g., *, ~, \$, etc.).

Electronic ID Card

With our electronic ID cards, your insurance card is as close as your phone!

request a permanent card be mailed out to you.

The UHCSR Mobile App is available on both GooglePlay and the AppStore. Once you've downloaded it to your mobile device, click on 'My ID Card' to view it as well as fax or email your card to a provider.





What's an EOB and why do I need it?

EOB stands for Explanation of Benefits. This is a document we send you to let you know a claim has been processed. The most important thing for you to remember is an EOB is NOT a bill. It's letting you know which healthcare provider has filed a claim on your behalf, what it was for, whether it was approved, and for how much. You should always review your EOB to make sure it's correct. Here's a breakdown on how to read your EOB.

In the upper right portion of your EOB you'll find general information. If a payment was made to the provider, you'll see the check details in the top boxes. Below that are things like the claim and policy number, your ID numbers, both the insured's and the patient's name, as well as the provider's name and address.
