- I. Eligible recipients should fit into at least one of the following categories
 - An individual who will have completed at least two years of college by September 2021 with plans to become a teacher.
 - An individual who wishes to make a career change within education.
 - A teacher wishing to change teaching fields.

- II. Applicant must have/had a connection with Independent School District 281.
Preferably: 281 graduate, present 281 teacher, current resident.

- III. Application Procedure:
 - A short autobiographical essay including education, occupation experiences.
 - Transcript of credits.
 - One paragraph statement describing financial needs.
 - Any additional information deemed important to your situation.

- IV. Deadline:
