

Topic: EduDentity Information


EduDentity is a tool that uses identity authentication when logging into D2L Brightspace. In short, if you teach at multiple campuses that use D2L Brightspace you can log into both with the same EduDentity credentials.

While you can use the app without having an EduDentity account, your ability to markup documents will be limited to PDF's. You will be able to view and provide a grade for other types of documents; however you will not be able to annotate them. Logging in with an EduDentity account unlocks all of the feedback tools including highlighter, underline, cross out text, draw and write and comments for all supported document types.

Signing up for an EduDentity Account:

You can sign up for an EduDentity account when logging into the iPad App for the first time or by going to the following URL: <https://edudentity.com/web/account/create>

Provide the information that it asks for and it will ask you to confirm the account in an e-mail you will be sent. After you complete these steps you will be able to log into the assignment grader using EduDentity.
