

Start of Semester Checklist for D2L Brightspace

Use the following list to help in completing your “start of semester” tasks.

D2L Brightspace Checklist

New MSUM instructor or using D2L Brightspace for the first time?


If you are a new MSUM instructor or using D2L Brightspace for the first time, request a ‘development’ course.

Complete a D2L Brightspace Development Course Request for *at least one* of your upcoming courses. This will create a working/archive course and also set up your ‘teacher’ account on D2L Brightspace.

To request a ‘devel’ course, go to the [D2L Brightspace Development Course Request Form](https://my.mnstate.edu/ITS/Forms/RequestD2LDevelopmentCourse) at: <https://my.mnstate.edu/ITS/Forms/RequestD2LDevelopmentCourse>

Enter your StarID and password to log into the form.

Find your courses on the D2L Brightspace “My Home” page

1. Log into [D2L Brightspace](#) and check for your courses.
2. Use the waffle , the 9-point image at the top of your “My Home” page, to display your courses by the number for the term. For example, fall 2020 courses begin with 20213.

Verify course access dates for students

By default, D2L Brightspace courses are set to open at 12:00 a.m. the first day of classes and close at 11:59 p.m. the last day of finals.

You can modify your course start to provide early access to your course and/or extend the course if desired. Course end dates are automatically extended part way through the semester. Additional information and steps are provided in the [Course Start/End Dates](#) tutorial.

Copy course materials from your development course (or previous semester)

If you have taught this course before on D2L Brightspace, you can copy the content from your Development Course (or a previously taught course) to the new Course Shell.

Update your course components

Announcements

- Post a welcome message in Announcements on the Course Home page.
- Click **Announcements** and review any messages that you may have copied over from a previous semester.
- All messages listed in **Published** status will display to your students. If you want to hide a published message, you can delete the message or change the status to “Expired.” To expire a message, click on the message link, select the check box for “Remove news item based on end date,” change the date and/or time if you wish, and click **Update**.
- Clicking the ‘X’ to dismiss the announcement item on your Course Home page does NOT hide it from your students. It only **dismisses** the message **from your view**.
- Be sure to change roles temporarily to Student to see what a student might see on the Announcements widget and update as appropriate.

Gradebook

- Run through the Grade Wizard at least one time to make sure your settings are correct.
- Add or update your grade items on Manage Grades as necessary.

Content

- Edit your modules and/or topic titles as needed. Be sure to check for places where you indicated due dates in the titles.
- Upload your new syllabus.
- Add or update the other content in your course as necessary.
- Check ALL links.

Discussions

- Add or edit discussion forums and topics.
- Make any necessary changes to Groups if using small group discussions.

To edit the Start, End, and/or Due Date for a discussion folder:

1. Click on the drop-down for the Discussion topic and select the **Edit** option.
2. Under the Locking Options heading, select the option button for “Unlock topic for a specific date range” (if it is not selected already).
3. Select the “Has End Date” check box (if it is not selected already).
4. Change the date and time in the “Has End Date” field to the new due date.
5. Click **Save and Close**.

Assignments

- Add or edit assignments

To edit the Start, End, and/or Due Date for an assignment folder:

1. Click on the drop-down next to the name of the Assignment and select Edit Folder.
2. Display the **Restrictions** tab and change the Start and End dates.
3. Click **Save and Close** to save your changes to the assignment folder.
4. Alternatively, you can edit multiple folders at one time using the following steps:
 - a. Select which folders you wish to edit (or the all check box at the top of the list).
 - b. Click **More Actions**.
 - c. Click the “Bulk Edit” icon above the list of Assignment folders.
 - d. Make any necessary changes and click **Save and Close**.

Quizzes

- Add or edit quizzes.

To edit the Start and/or End Dates for a quiz:

1. Open the quiz.
2. Display the **Restrictions** tab.
3. Change the Start and End dates.
4. Click **Save and Close**.
