


Topic: Self-Assessments

Self-Assessments in D2L Brightspace are assessments that allow the professor to get feedback from you, the student. These self-assessments are NOT grades nor do they have a point value.

To access Self-Assessments, click the **Assessments** menu and click **Self Assessments**.
