

Topic: Submitting Large Media Files for Courses

With YouTube and Assignments, there are limitations for students trying to upload extremely large video files. To avoid this conflict, students should burn their file onto a **DATA DVD**.

This is just a regular DVD-R blank disc, but burned as a data disc, and not a DVD video disc. This will give up to **4.7 GB** of space. The Windows 7 and 8 operating systems along with the Mac OS will burn a DVD without any additional software needed.
