

I want to go on an MSUM exchange program. What do I do?

- ◆ Select your program after discussion with your advisor and the Office of Study Abroad. (See reverse side for available exchange programs.)
- ◆ Visit the Office of Study Abroad to obtain the application form and instructions.
- ◆ Pay your application fee, turn in your completed form, and the Office of Study Abroad will contact you to set up an interview.
- ◆ Once accepted, you'll be mailed a packet which you need to complete in full and return to the Office of Study Abroad.

(Note: you **must** complete this packet in order to be eligible to study abroad, be registered for courses, and receive financial aid.)

- ◆ Do you have a valid passport?
- ◆ Do you need an ISIC card?
- ◆ Do you need a visa for the country you're studying in?
- ◆ All students must be in good academic standing and good conduct standing to be eligible to study abroad. There may be additional admission requirements (i.e. higher GPA requirement) for some exchanges.
